The objective is to ensure that individuals are given the opportunity to move into the next level of service.

#### **Job Summary:**

Staff member working as part of a team to ensure that each client staying in the building has the opportunity and support for independence to their individual preferences. Community Living Workers help to create and maintain a safe, respectful environment, and assist with clerical and security support.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Completion of a recognized Addictions Worker or Mental Health Worker certificate or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience
- Ability to deal with others effectively
- Ability to work independently but within a team environment
- Ability to work under pressure and organize work while maintaining time restrictions
- Ability in conflict resolution and personnel interaction
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing
- Physical ability to carry out the duties of the position
